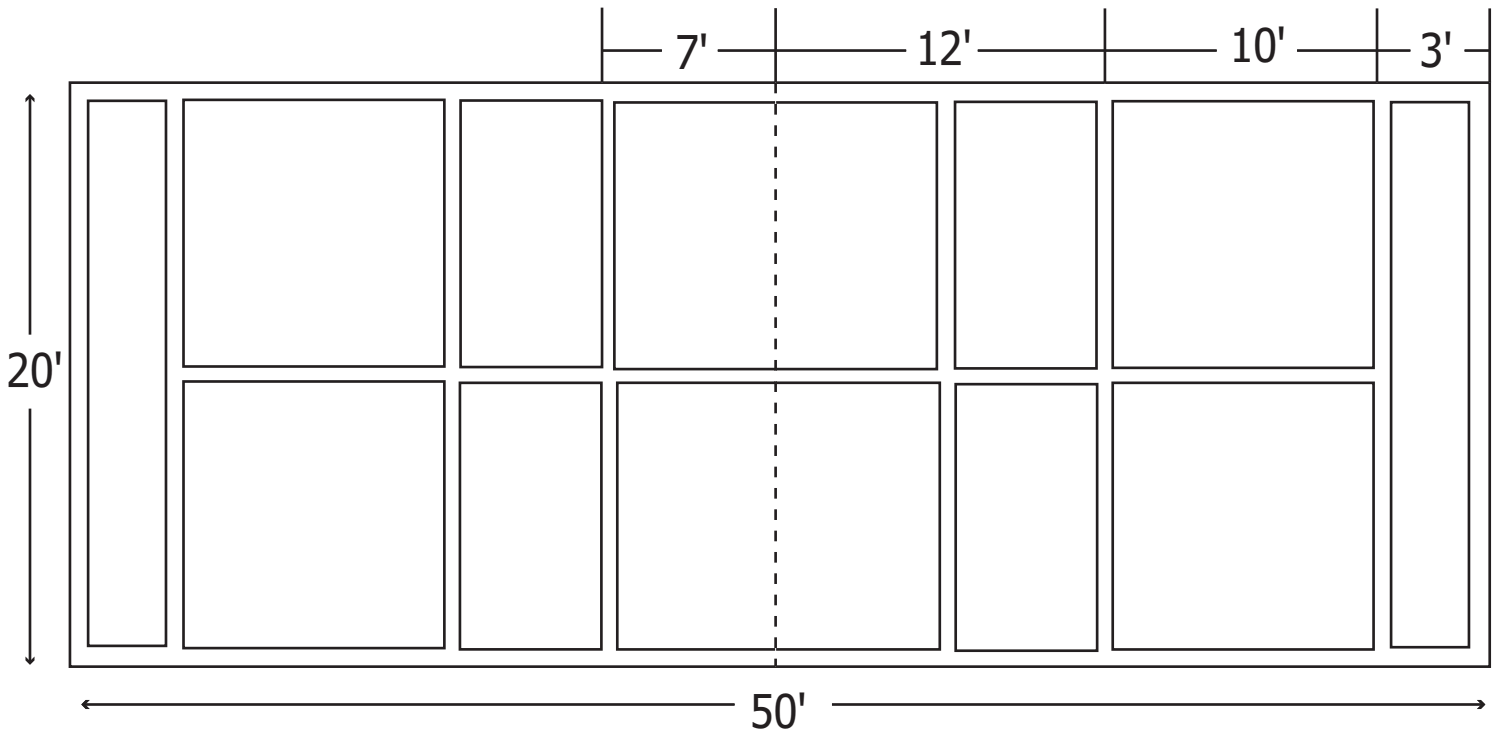




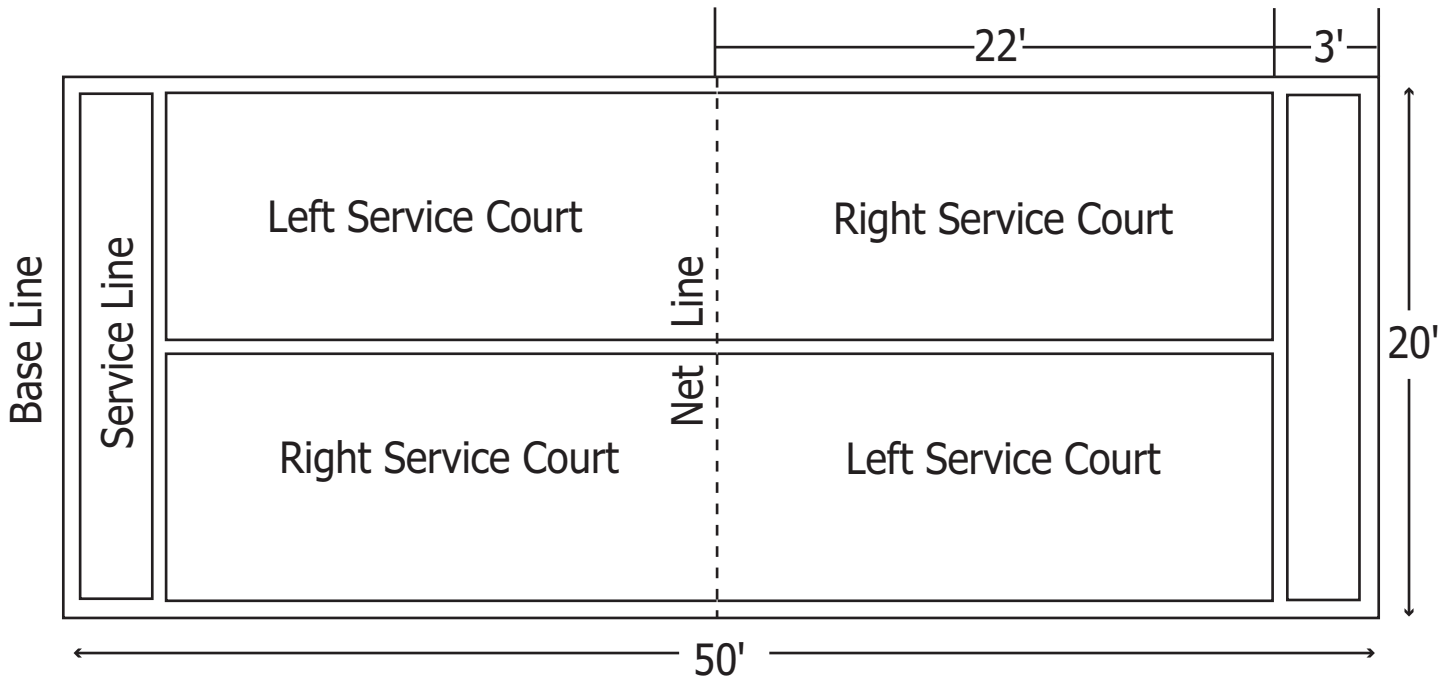
# COURT LAYOUTS

A Problem with any multiple use court is the amount of lines required for official play of each sport. This can create confusion during play. The Unicourt Court Layout is a compromise that allows play for 4 Paddle/Racquet sports; Paddle Tennis, Pickle Ball, Action Tennis and Soft Tennis. Included are the official line layouts for the individual sports. Note that these lines are boundary lines and do not show the actual playing area required that varies from sport to sport. The U.S. Paddle Tennis Association recommends the over all playing area to be 40' wide by 80' long. This does not mean that Paddle Tennis cannot be played within a smaller playing area but does mean that the players are limited somewhat to their aggressiveness with returns outside the boundary lines.

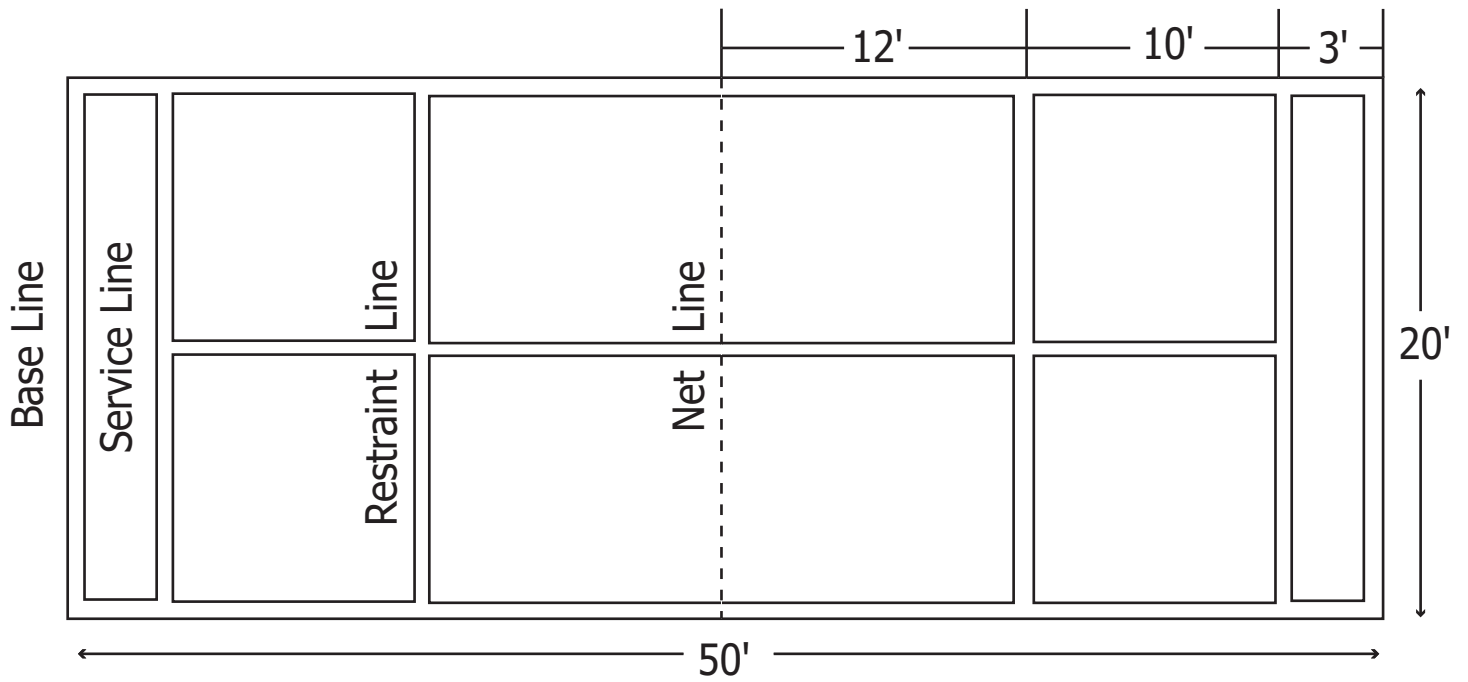

### Eastern Paddle Tennis Court Layout

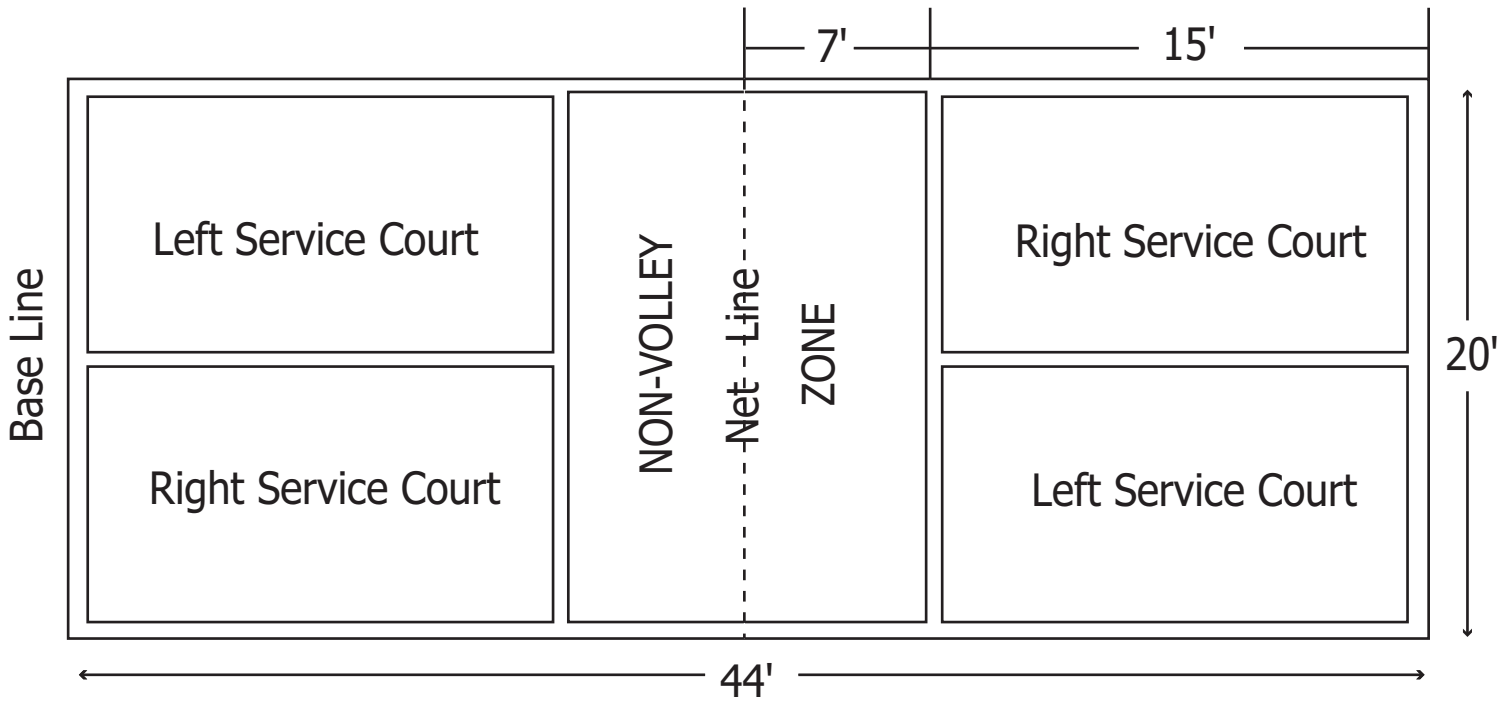


### Western Paddle Tennis Court Layout

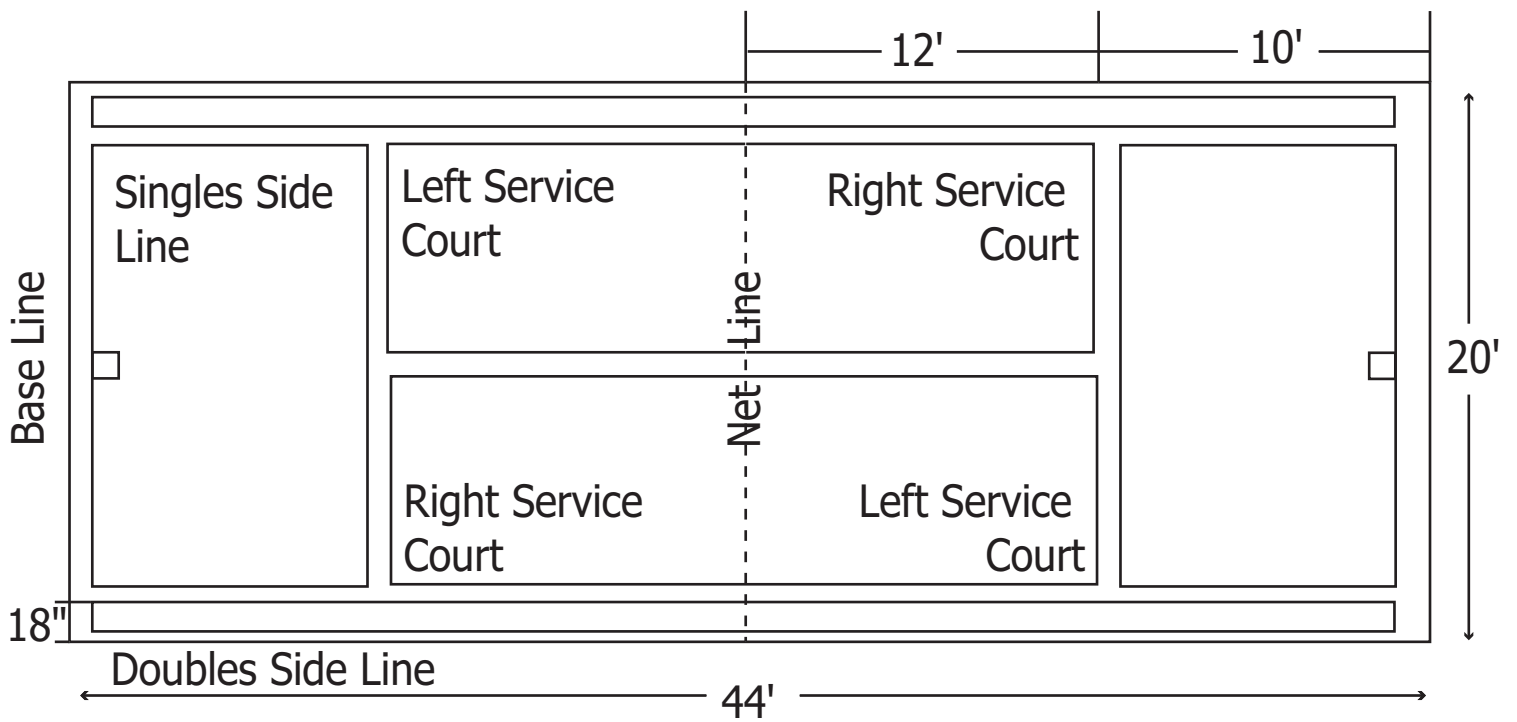


Note: The Service Court area is the same as shown in the Eastern Paddle Tennis Court Layout.
